

The Reverend Larry Christian Green, Sr. was born and reared in Virginia. He is a graduate of Virginia Union University with a Bachelor of Science degree in biology and extensive work towards a Master of Science degree in microbiology at Virginia State University. He has also received a Master of Divinity degree from The School of Theology, Virginia Union University and a Master of Theology degree from Union Theological Seminary of Virginia.

He served as pastor of Grace Baptist Church of Waterbury, Connecticut from October of 1984 until retiring in December of 2013.
