

The Reverend Larry Christian Green, Sr. was born and reared in Virginia. He is a graduate of Virginia Union University with a Bachelor of Science degree in biology and extensive work towards a Master of Science degree in microbiology at Virginia State University. He has also received a Master of Divinity degree from The School of Theology, Virginia Union University and a Master of Theology degree from Union Theological Seminary of Virginia.

The Reverend Mr. Green worked as an environmental planner for the Virginia State Water Control Board before entering the ministry. He served as pastor of the First Union Baptist Church of Richmond, Virginia before accepting the call to serve as pastor of the Grace Baptist Church of Waterbury, Connecticut. He served as pastor of Grace Baptist Church from October of 1984 until retiring in December of 2013. Under his leadership Grace Baptist Church experienced a number of innovative changes including expansion of leadership to include women and young adults, revitalized children and youth programs, contemporary worship services and remodeling and doubling the size of the existing church building.

In addition to his service as pastor of Grace Baptist Church, The Reverend Larry C. Green, Sr. was very active in state and local affairs during his time in Connecticut. He has served as a member of the board of directors for Western Connecticut Area Agency on Aging, Waterbury Opportunities Industrialization Center, The Community Foundation, St. Mary's Hospital and the Greater Waterbury Interfaith Ministries (past president), The American Baptist Churches of Connecticut and The Connecticut State Missionary Baptist Convention. He served as president of Grace Development Corporation of Waterbury which developed and operates Grace House, providing 40 units of affordable, independent living apartments for seniors. He also served as president of Grace Congregate Housing Corporation of Waterbury which developed and operates Hearth Homes, 41 units of affordable senior housing. The corporations also developed and operated an adult day care facility.

The Reverend Larry C. Green, Sr. is married to Dr. Dorothy Libron-Green, a retired professor of mathematics. They are the proud parents of two children and four grandchildren. He currently resides in Sarasota, Florida and is a Summer resident of Martha's Vineyard where he serves as a member of the Union Chapel Trustees.
